Proposed By-laws Amendment

Add to Article III, Funds

G. Funds may be set aside for the purchase of, lease of, or improvements to a future flying field.

Undesignated gifts or bequests to the club will be put in this fund. This fund will be deposited in an interest bearing account and separate from other accounts of the Club. Distribution of funds shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Screaming Eagles R/C Club New Field Fund Policy dated January 2005. The state of this account will be reported to the membership monthly.

Screaming Eagles R/C Club New Field Fund Policy

1. NAME OF FUND. The fund shall be named the Screaming Eagles R/C Club New Field Fund, herein referred to as the Fund.
2. PURPOSE. The purpose of the Fund shall be to accept, accumulate, and realize gains on, the funds donated for the sole purpose of acquiring and/or bringing to flying condition the next flying site for the Screaming Eagles R/C Club, AMA Charter Club 298, herein referred to as SE.
3. DISTRIBUTION. Distributions of the Fund shall be as specified in PURPOSE above and require the approval of SE Executive Committee, and approval of the membership. No amounts in excess of what is needed to meet the purpose specified in PURPOSE above shall be expended.
4. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS. Funds will be sought from members or other sources, however, only voluntary member contributions will be accepted for the initial establishment of this fund. Funds will be solicited and accepted to establish this fund for a period of one year beginning January 2005. The initial campaign goal is \$1000. The total fund will then be deposited in an account separate from other SE general accounts with restrictions established herein. There are no restrictions on the source of funds after the Fund is established. The selected account will be agreed upon by the Executive Committee. The Club Treasurer will be the fund manager and will be responsible for accepting donations and reporting to the Executive Committee and membership
5. CONTINUITY OF THE FUND. The Fund will be terminated when the SE purchase land for a permanent flying site as directed above or upon legal dissolution of the SE for a period of five (5) years. If the SE has not maintained its AMA charter for a period of 5 years, the fund will be distributed to the AMA Flying Site Development/Improvement Grant Program.
6. ACCOUNTING. The SE Treasurer will report the status of this account to the membership monthly.
7. INVESTMENT OF FUNDS. The SE shall have all powers to invest and reinvest the Fund, except the power to commingle the assets of the Fund with its other funds for any purpose.
